### **Wigan**

- The Museum of Wigan Life (*runs free child-friendly activities throughout the holidays such as Animal Mummies Uncovered*)

### **Bolton**

- Bolton Museum (*excellent Ancient Egypt section!*)

### **Liverpool**

- World Museum (*Mrs Kirkup's childhood favourite! Take a packed lunch and eat in the picnic room on a rainy day!*)
- The Walker Art Gallery (*next door but one to the World Museum; check out the Big Art room where the children can dress up and create a piece of art before looking at the portraits, can you spot any Kings or Queens?*)
- Museum of Liverpool Life (*contributions of Liverpool to national life*)
- Merseyside Maritime Museum (*uncover the findings from the Titanic*)

### **Manchester**

- Manchester Museum (*Home to an array of treasures from the natural world and many cultures*)
- Museum of Science and Industry (*Uncover Manchester's role in the Industrial Revolution*)
- People's History Museum (*Looking at local and national working class life*)

### **Warrington**

- Warrington Museum (*travel through time around the Museum and Art Gallery. Also home to the library to share stories!*)
