Reception.

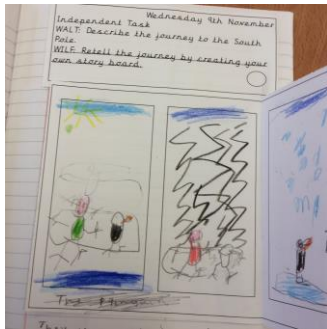


Reception had a fantastic time at the Bridgewater Hall where they watched and took part in a performance of The Rainbow Fish.

Year 4.



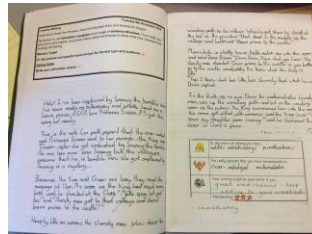
