Monday 17th October: Fire safety talk by fire brigade for Y6

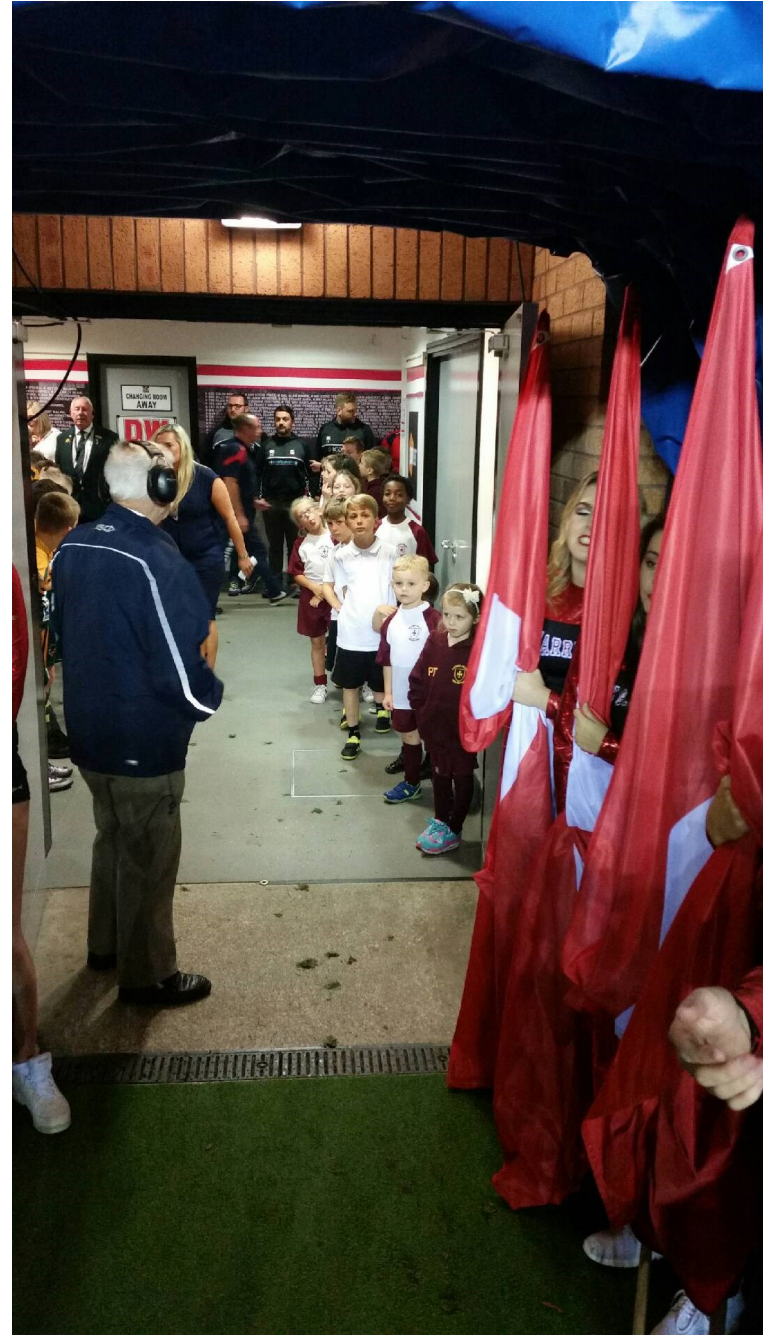
Thursday 20th October: Y6 rugby festival at Leigh Sports Village
