Year One

This unit builds on the content covered n Reception. It introduces days of the week, colours and numbers 11-20. As children learn more numbers and colours, it will enable them to start describing objects around them.

Useful prior Knowledge:

- *Greetings
- *Numbers 1-10.

New language Content:

- *Saying the days of the week
- *Naming colours
- *Counting between 11-20
- *Naming countries
- *Expressing likes and dislikes.

Autumn:

- Recognise the days of the week spoke in sequence

Children will learn the days of the week in French. This can be done through song. Children can also continue to answer simple questions such as what day is it? And responding with it is...

Understand most colours

Children will also begin to learn a range of colours children will begin to answer the question: What colour is it? And respond with It's...

Spring:

- Understand numbers up to 20

Recap with the children numbers 1-10 and then focus on learning numbers 11-20. Children will again begin to answer questions such as: How many biscuits are there? Responding in French.

- Respond to guestions about likes and dislikes with a single word.

Children will be able to respond to words such as:

Yes and No

and begin to recognize other French words such as:

The chocolate, The music, The biscuits ect..

Answering questions such as do you like? And responding with: yes I like... Or no, I don't like...

Summer:

- Recognise negative responses to question when given a visual prompt.

Children will recap all prior knowledge taught over year one. Developing there answering question from single words to phrase such as: I like ,I don't like.

Children can continue to develop their vocabulary with different French words and can enjoys a Monster story which will include some numbers and colours to consolidate learning.
