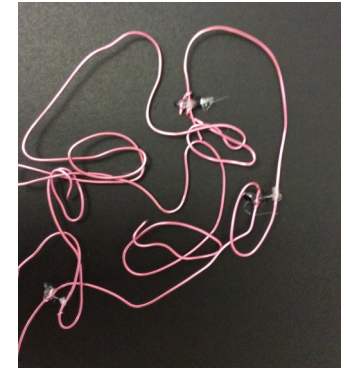


Key Stage 2
