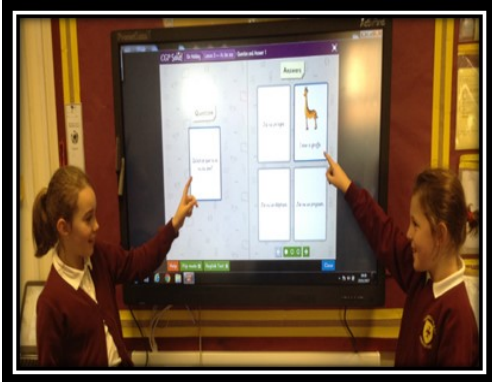

Year 4

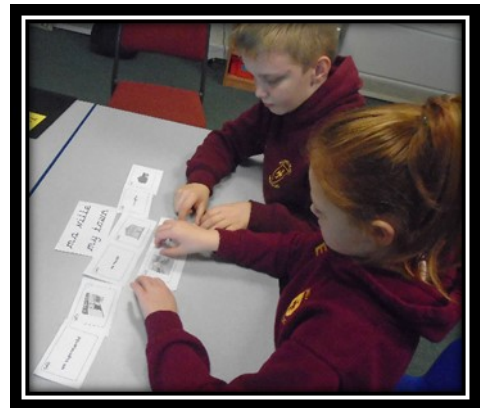
Year 4 have started to learn about what they can see in their town. Children can understand and give simple directions to town various buildings and can write a few simple sentences about where they live.
